### "Safe & dynamic fieldtrips during the pandemic"

## Team Sweden actors present smart solutions and safety precautions when designing physical and digital fieldtrips. Q&A.

A high priority within Swedish Development Cooperation involves normative dialogue to enable realisation of Swedish development prioritises. Many actors have however struggled to endure dynamic partnerships and enhanced normative dialogue throughout the covid-19 pandemic. While digital platforms and tools have been effectively utilised to compensate for cancelled flight arrangements, the need to maintain safe and trust-based interactions still remains. Some Team Sweden actors have therefore taken the decision to start conducting fieldtrips aligned with covid-19 restrictions. These actors have managed to navigate around the complex precautionary context. What are some of the lessons learned and best practises from these recent fieldtrips? What are the key concerns to take in considerations (PCR-test, insurance, security procedures, quarantine and social distancing etc.)? In what situations are physical fieldtrips not necessary? What are the best practices for digital fieldtrips and mixed/hybrid forms? How do we ensure that the dialogue continues to advance in the light of the covid-19 era?
